These Masses are announced simply as “for the intention” of the individual. There will be a second collection this weekend for Summer Subscription. As always, thank you for your generosity in helping maintain our lovely campus.

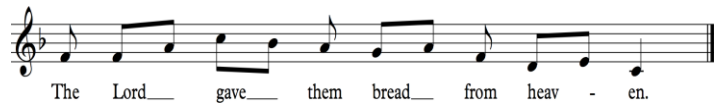
Hamilton Food Cupboard
