I believe the publication of our parish financial reports are an important step in inviting our parishioners to co-responsibility and co-ownership over the financial future of our parishes. I am hopeful that by publishing said reports on a yearly basis we will create a sense of transparency that will give rise to increased interest from parishioners in supporting the future viability of our parishes.
