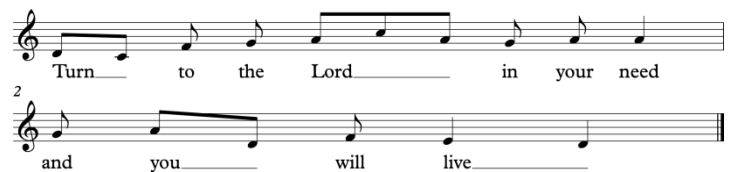
Hamilton Food Cupboard
