### **Parish Family Rosary (Homes United in Prayer)**

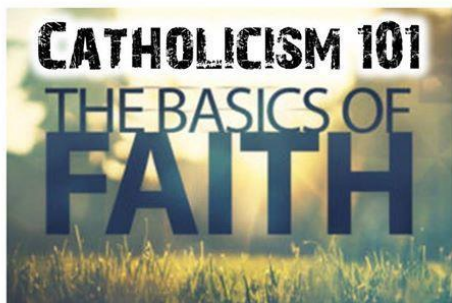
