Ordination to the Priesthood

Father Hage will be attending Rev. Mr. Matthew Rawson's ordination to the priesthood on Saturday, June 2 at 10am at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. He will also be participating in the Holy Hour being offered the night before Matt's ordination at Our Lady of Hope Church in Syracuse on Friday, June 1 at 6pm. Lastly, Father Hage will be attending Father Rawson's first Mass as a priest on Sunday, June 3 at 11:15am at Our Lady of Hope Church in Syracuse. Please pray for Matthew as well as an increase in vocations to the priesthood in the Diocese of Syracuse.

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

This weekend we celebrate our diocesan ordinations to the priesthood. Every first Saturday of June our diocese schedules our priestly ordinations. Matthew Rawson, from Our Lady of Hope Church in Syracuse, will be ordained a priest for our diocese this weekend. This is a joyous time for our diocese as well as a sober reminder that we need to continue to fervently pray for an increase in vocations (Father Rawson will be ordained without any classmates). I am sure you have also noticed that the 11am Mass at St. Mary's this weekend is being offered for a Father Donald Keefe, S.J. Father Keefe was a native of Hamilton and grew up in Saint Mary's Church. His family farm is still standing in the Hamilton area. Father Keefe died on February 27 of this year and is buried at Auriesville, NY. He was one of the few men from our area who was ordained to the priesthood. Our last living vocation from our parish is Father Edmund Castronovo, who was ordained for our diocese in 1976. He is currently assigned to Our Lady of Good Counsel in Verona, NY. It has been over 40 years since a vocation came from our area. I think it is also providential that we celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Without priests, there is no Eucharist. Please join me in prayer that a young man from among our parishes will answer the call to the priesthood. Also join me in prayer that a young woman from among our parishes will answer the call to religious life. Our prayers mean more in this equation than you may know.
