**FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE**

I am so excited about our upcoming Lenten Parish Mission. This parish mission is a collaborative event between St. Mary's and St. Joan's. I pray all of our parishioners will join me on Monday, April 1 at 7pm for a life-changing night that will inspire the whole family. Msgr. Robert Yeazel will be our guest presenter, and he will be offering his insights into how we can improve communication within the family, among our loved ones, and in our homes. The title of his talk will be, "The Awesome Power of Listening." This event will be hosted at St. Mary's in Hamilton. Msgr. Yeazel was ordained a priest for the Syracuse Diocese in 1967 and then continued his education completing a master's degree in child and family studies at Syracuse University. He is a native of St. Daniel's Parish in Lyncourt. From 1973 to 1977, Msgr. Yeazel served as vice chancellor of the diocese and secretary to Bishop David Cunningham. In 1977 he was appointed chancellor and continued in that position for three years. He was named pastor of Immaculate Conception Church in Fayetteville in 1980 and served there for 12 years. During that time, Msgr. Yeazel was appointed regional vicar of the Western Region of the diocese. From 1992 to 2000, he served as vicar for Priests. He was appointed pastor of Holy Cross Church in DeWitt in 2000 and spearheaded the construction of the new church building. He retired from Holy Cross in the spring of 2017 and now helps out at Holy Family Church in Syracuse. Please come out this Monday to give Msgr. Yeazel a warm welcome to our parish communities. Mary Immaculate and St. Joan of Arc, pray for us.
