**FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE**

Here is a portion of a recent message that went out from Bishop Cunningham to all of the priests in the Diocese of Syracuse:

*"All of us are concerned for the victims of abuse and will do all that we can to accompany them on their journey of hope and healing. Pope Francis reminds us that these efforts must be grounded in prayer and fasting. For this reason, I am asking that together we observe the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows (September 15) as a day of prayer and fasting throughout the Diocese of Syracuse, for the hope and healing of victims and for the forgiveness of our sins. I ask that our churches be open for an extended period of time on September 15 for those who wish to have an opportunity to visit the Blessed Sacrament. At the evening Mass on Saturday, September 15, I ask that in all the parishes in our Diocese the Mass prayers be those for the forgiveness of sins....Purple vestments may be worn. Please ask your people to join us in fasting on September 15 and in prayer that weekend. Nothing that we do will be able to fully heal those who have suffered at the hands of our brothers, but we must try...."*

## **New Parish Holy Hours!**

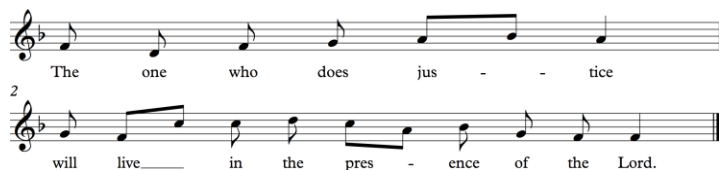
