FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

First of all, I would like to congratulate both of our parishes, St. Joan's and St. Mary's, for achieving their HOPE Appeal goals! What a tremendous accomplishment for our Catholic Community in Southern Madison County. I am deeply grateful to the parishioners who helped us reach our goals, and I am proud of our efforts to help maintain our standard of excellence in all things parish related. Secondly, I would like to share some recent news about my own life. Bishop Lucia has recently appointed me the Director of Vocation Promotion for the diocese. I am both stunned and humbled by this appointment. As Vocation Director, I will be overseeing all of our diocesan outreach to young people discerning a vocation. This role comes with great responsibility, but I felt the need to say yes because without this work of promoting vocations our local church will have no future. As I always say, without the priest there is no Eucharist, and without the Eucharist there is no Church. My appointment is effective October 1, after which I will begin to spend at least one day a week in the chancery. As Bishop Lucia reminded me on our phone call, the heart of priestly ministry is the parish, and I am to maintain my commitment to my own parishes as I take on this new role. Please pray for me and for an increase in vocations in the Diocese of Syracuse.

They will know how to set up a program where you will simply push the button on your hearing aid to activate the T-Coil. Tell them it is important to match the gain curve output of the T-Coil setting to the standard gain curve of your everyday setting.
